II. Welcome and Introductions

III. SHAB This Year

- A. Gaby Bustos Ramos and Jenny Guov want members to be involved with the annual budget presentation to SIFC during Winter 2016 and promote SHS and health in the community. SHS is the location of the new Survivor Advocacy and Resource Center (SARC) and expanded violence prevention services. Jenny G. suggested promoting the SHS Tebeau Clinic this year.
- B. Jenny Haubenreiser announced that SHS recently hired Assistant Director of Health Promotion Amanda Daugherty, who would be joining future SHAB meetings to help with student projects. Jenny H. discussed the SHS budgeting process as the primary purpose of SHAB. During the fee approval process with ASOSU SHAB members will have the opportunity to tell SIFC the story of SHS and how SHS contributes to student success. The SIFC has undergone changes since last year. As SHAB Chair, Gaby is a member of the SIFC. Jenny H. suggests that SHAB also look at opportunities to promote health, SHS, student insurance, Tebeau Clinic, and Public Health. The Grand Opening of the SARC will be October 8, 5:30-7:30pm at SHS. Kris Winter, Associate Dean of Student Life, will advise the SIFC this year.
- C. With Gaby serving on both SHAB and SIFC, Gaby and Jenny Guov will serve in equal roles on SHAB and share SHAB duties accordingly.
- D. Jenny G. suggested projects to consider for Fall 2015: (1) CAPS Advisory Board meetings with SHAB. (2) SHAB members could be responsible for learning about and promoting health insurance and the Affordable Care Act. (3) Promote Student Health Services programs and Tebeau Clinic Same Day services.
- E. Gaby and Lyndi Petty (SHAB member from last year) organized the Tebeau Same Day Clinic Grand Opening during Winter 2015. Jenny H. suggested a similar event at Tebeau Clinic focusing on serving the international student population.
- F. Jenny H. announced that SHS has hired five Student Health Navigators to greet people near the reception desk at SHS. SHS would like to hire a Navigator for international students to help explain health insurance and the US health care system.
- G. George Voss encourages students to be involved in health education and promotion, in addition to the SHS budget. He welcomes questions and invites SHAB members to meet with him.
- H. SIFC will meet Thursday October 8. There was a question whether Gaby can present the budget to SIFC this year if she also serves on SIFC, to avoid a conflict of interest. Jenny H. suggested that other students present the budget and that Gaby would not vote on the SHS budget. Catherine

Huang said that a CAPS advisory board member, not chair, would serve on SIFC to avoid a conflict.

- I. George and Jenny H. discussed collaborative projects with SHS, CAPS, Dixon Recreational Services, and Housing. Jenny H. encourages members to meet Rae Madison, Director of ASOSU Wellness Affairs.
